Ways to Use The After Party in Your Church

Options	Typical Format	What it Looks Like	Perfect for
Groups (Small & Large!)	6-week journey of 2- hour sessions per week.	Host a discussion group in your home, meet at a coffee shop with a few friends, or go through it as a church-wide study with breakout discussions.	Your personal small group, Bible study, or a larger gathering at your church.
Workshop	1 to 3-day intensive with approximately 6 hours of content in total.	Set aside a half-day or weekend to dive into the material, either in person or online. This could look like a structured church event, a ministry leadership retreat, or a focused group session.	Ideal for leadership retreats, church-wide workshops, or conferences, this option provides an immersive experience with dedicated time to process—perfect for churches with time constraints.

Options	Typical Format	What it Looks Like	Perfect for
Book Study	Weekly chapter discussions over 6 weeks	Read The After Party book together, then discuss a chapter or section at a time. Great for those who love deep conversation and thoughtful reflection.	Book clubs, Bible study groups, or anyone who prefers to learn through reading.
Worship & Prayer	Weave into your daily rhythms and church life	Incorporate <i>The</i> <i>After Party</i> into a time of worship and guided prayer, using our worship album created in partnership with <i>The</i> <i>Porter's Gate</i> to deepen the experience. Whether woven into a service, small group gathering, or personal devotion, these songs—along with available sheet music—help center hearts on Christ as we engage with the material.	Perfect for churches, prayer groups, or individuals looking to integrate The After Party's biblical principles into worship, prayer, and spiritual formation.





1. Running a TAP Group/Course?

The full <u>six-session TAP course</u> is designed to help your church navigate faith and politics with **wisdom**, **love**, **and humility**. It can be used in two formats:

<u>Small Groups:</u> Encourage your existing small groups to go through **The** After Party together. Each week, they'll watch a short video, engage in deep discussion, and reflect on how faith shapes their political engagement.

<u>Sunday School or Larger Church Classes:</u> Looking for something beyond small groups? Use TAP in a **class setting**—a weekly gathering where church members walk through the content together. This works well for a**dult discipleship classes, Bible studies, or a midweek gathering.**

How to Start:

- Register for the course at <u>after-party.org</u> to access videos and materials.
- Have small group leaders or class facilitators review the *Facilitator Guide* to prepare.
- Provide participants with <u>workbooks</u> (digital or printed) so they can follow along.

2. Running a TAP Workshop

Want to introduce the conversation in a shorter time frame? The TAP Workshop condenses the course into a one-day or multi-day experience.

1, 2, or 3-Day Seminar:

- **One-Day Intensive:** A deep dive into the material in a **4-6 hour session.**
- <u>Weekend Retreat:</u> Spread the content over two days for more reflection and discussion time.
- <u>Three-Day Experience:</u> Go even deeper, with more time for processing and prayer.

📌 How to Start:

- Choose a format and date that works best for your church.
- Secure a venue with space for both large group teaching and small group discussions.
- Assign a <u>main facilitator</u> and, if possible, **small group leaders** to guide discussion.
- Register for the course and provide workbooks for participants.

The workshop format is a great way to engage a larger audience quickly whether it's a special event for your congregation or a leadership retreat.





Prefer a **book-based study** instead of a video course? <u>The After Party</u> <u>book</u> follows the same content as the course, but with additional **stories**, **reflections**, and **exercises** for deeper engagement.


Perfect for:

- <u>A traditional book club</u>—meeting weekly to discuss a few chapters at a time.
- A <u>self-paced small group</u> that reads the book together and follows the included discussion prompts.
- <u>Supplementing the TAP course</u> for those who want to go deeper or prefer reading over video content.

📌 How to Start:

- Get copies of <u>The After Party book</u> for participants.
- Use the discussion questions provided in the book to guide conversations.
- Consider pairing the book with the video sessions for a hybrid approach.

This is a great option for **those who love reading**, **those who process better through written material**, **or those who can't commit to a structured video study**.

Ways to Use This in Your Church:


- Incorporate the songs into Sunday worship—helping your congregation reflect on the heart of TAP.
